## Arete Scholars Participating Schools Policies and Procedures

- Partner schools will allow Arete Scholars to list their school on our website (www.aretescholars.org) as an official Arete Scholars partner school.
- Partner Schools agree to follow the rules and procedures put forth in R.S.47:6301 and Bulletin134, as amended.
- Students may receive scholarships from multiple STOs, as long as the total combined value of the award does not exceed the actual tuition and fees at the qualified school.
- Participating students may also stack SCP or GATOR scholarships with TDC scholarships. Please note that combined awards must not exceed actual tuition and mandatory fees.
- Arete Scholars sends quarterly scholarship payments to the partner school on the student's behalf. Prior to
  each payment, schools must verify enrollment. Scholarship payments are made via ACH to the school on
  behalf of the parent/guardian. The parent/guardian must approve the payment.
- By law, Arete Scholars pays the school for the full quarters that the student is enrolled. Once the child
  withdraws, payments will cease. Scholarships are portable to other Arete-participating schools, and the
  amount will be prorated.
- Partner schools agree to provide Arete Scholars the following information regarding participating students annually. All submitted documentation will remain confidential and is for research purposes only. Any information obtained will be used for aggregate reporting purposes:
  - o Course/End year grades
  - Standardized test scores
  - o Official Transcripts
  - o Behavior & Attendance Records

## Louisiana Law Requirements for TDC Participating Schools

Schools are solely responsible for reading, understanding and following the rules and procedures set forth in R.S.47:6301 and Bulletin134, as amended. Please visit www.louisianabelieves.com for the law in its entirety. Schools participating in the Tuition Donation Credit Program are required by Louisiana Law to meet the following requirements:

- Schools must be BESE approved and Brumfield v. Dodd compliant.
- Qualified Schools must conduct criminal background checks on employees in compliance with La. R.S.17:15
- Qualified Schools must annually administer any norm-referenced, BESE-approved, standardized test of the school's choosing to students who receive funding through the TDC program.
- Qualified Schools shall annually provide Arete Scholars with their current tuition and fees document. The tuition and fees reported for TDC students may not be higher than these published fees.
- Qualified Schools must abide by the Enrollment of Scholarship Receipts guidelines as set forth in Bulletin 134, Chapter 11.
- Qualified Schools (that have been in business less than five years) that receive more than \$50,000 in scholarship
  donations from a school tuition organization (STO) shall demonstrate its financial viability by filing, prior to the
  start of a school year, a surety bond payable to the STO in an amount equal to the aggregate amount of
  donations expected to be received during the school year.
