NEW SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATIONS WILL BE ACCEPTED BEGINNING MARCH 12, 2019.

Through the Louisiana Tuition Donation Credit Program (TDC), Arete Scholars provides K-12 scholarships to qualified low-to-moderate-income students, empowering parents to choose the nonpublic school that will best prepare your children for college, careers, and life.



ARETE SCHOLARS

Scholarships are awarded on a first-come, first-served basis, with priority given to current TDC and Louisiana Scholarship Program students. Award amounts are capped annually at 80% of the state's per student expense for students in grades K-8 and 90% for high schoolers. **For 2019-20, scholarship limits are \$4,228.61 for K-8 students and \$4,757.18 for grades 9-12.**

To be eligible for a scholarship in 2019-20 students must meet the following requirements:

1. Louisiana resident, **AND**
2. Enrolled in Louisiana public school for 2018-19, **OR**
 - Entering kindergarten in 2019-20, **OR**
 - Received a TDC scholarship or Louisiana Scholarship Program award in 2018-19, **AND**
3. Family income may not exceed the guidelines below

If your child meets **all** of the eligibility requirements, you may apply online beginning March 12th at AreteScholars.org. The application link will go live at 9:00AM CST and a \$30 application processing fee will apply. In addition to your application, you will need to submit your most recent federal income tax return, all W-2 forms, proof of residency, and supporting documentation for non-taxable income. A complete list of required documents can be found on our website.

The application deadline is currently March 31, 2019, but is subject to change pending available funds. Check AreteScholars.org for updates or changes to the deadline. Funding is limited, and application does not guarantee a scholarship.
