



NEW SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATIONS WILL BE ACCEPTED BEGINNING MARCH 22, 2022

Through the Louisiana Tuition Donation Credit Program (TDC), Arete Scholars provides K-12 scholarships to qualified low-to-moderate-income students, empowering parents to choose the nonpublic school that will best prepare your children for college, careers, and life.



Scholarships are awarded on a first-come, first-served basis, with priority given to current TDC and Louisiana Scholarship

Program students. For 2022-23, maximum award amounts are \$4,300 for K-8 students and \$4,800 for grades 9-12.

To be eligible for a scholarship in 2022-23 students must meet the following requirements:

- 1. Louisiana resident, AND
- 2. Enrolled in Louisiana public school for 2021-22, OR
 - Entering kindergarten in 2022-23, OR
 - Received a TDC scholarship or Louisiana Scholarship Program award in 2021-22, AND
- 3. Family income may not exceed the guidelines below

If your child meets <u>all</u> of the eligibility requirements, you may apply online beginning March 22nd at <u>AreteScholars.org</u> or by scanning the QR Code. The application will go live at 9:00AM CST and a \$35 application processing fee will apply.

In addition to your application, you will be required to submit income and residency documents. A complete list of required documents can be found on our website.
